- *Stop it*



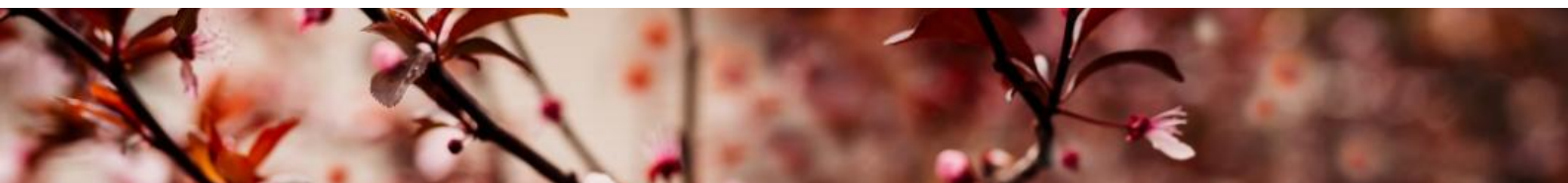

## From the Principal

### ***Term 2 Anti-Bullying focus***

In 2018 and 2019 we focussed on bullying as a whole school in term 2. Both years, we started with a whole school student audit of bullying behaviours at the end of term 1. This audit is unpacked by Governing Council Learning Committee, teaching staff and SSO's during unit meetings, students as part of the Wellbeing Student Action Team and Leadership, to consider issues or trends and to look for ways we can improve.

This year's data once again showed that rates of bullying are very low at Willunga Primary School with the majority of students recording little or no bullying interactions. However, we always strive to improve and so also consider what skills students will need to develop to become the successful and kind adults we want them to become and have the skills to manage bullying if it occurs in their life.

We identified last year a need to teach students skills around resilience and caring. We established a group called '*I Include*' that actively supports students having trouble in the yard. The Wellbeing SAT is currently auditing this program to see how we can make it even more effective. We also initiated regular class meetings (in the Junior and Middle Primary these are usually daily) so that the class can take an active role in solving problems for each other. Doing this work so visibly, helps all children build their skills to problem solve when issues arise.

Last year we also developed a whole school pledge (which you can see on display near the office). All students signed off on the pledge in 2018 and have revisited it again in 2019. All new students to the school, meet with me within two weeks of starting at our school to discuss and sign the pledge. This consistent message across the school supports all of us to know our responsibilities towards keeping safe.

We all have a role to play in ensuring that students understand how to recognise and report bullying, but also how to help and support others through acts of kindness.

I look forward to seeing this continuing learning over the course of the term
